Dazzling Sky and Sparking Sea

Naoshima

Naoshima is an island in Seto Inland Sea which is one of well-known archipelagos in the world. In a Japanese comical picaresque novel named "*Hizakurige*" published 19th century, the picturesque scenery of the Inland Sea attributes to reflection of the sunlight in the sea and wired appearance of rock islands. Accordingly, Naoshima features the shining sunlight and its reflection.

Benesse Art Site

Chichu Art Museum designed by Tadao Ando is one of main architectures of Benesse Art Site. The museum was mostly built underground not to affect the natural scenery of the Seto Inland Sea. The buildings having the skylight are designed to maximize the




Chichu Art Museum takes diffused reflections of the sunshine in the middle of Seto Inland Sea.

impact of the art works. For example, the Claude Monet Space in a white underground chamber is designed to present Monet's Water Lily paintings in a perfect balance of light and space. A stay at Benesse House which is a combination museum and hotel, is like staying at modern art gallery.

Seto Inland Sea

Seto Inland Sea is not a true inland sea but rather a body of water lies between the Japanese main islands of Honshū, Shikoku, and Kyūshū. The Seto Inland Sea's mild climate and its islands' relaxed atmosphere invite comparisons with the Mediterranean Sea. The relax feelings are from picturesque scenaries such as a fishing boat in the sparkling sea under dazzling sky (see left). It reminds us of fond memories of hometown.



Bumpkin (Yellow)

There are two pumpkins installed in Miyanoura port (red) and Gotanji beach (yellow). The art works by Yayoi Kusama in 1994 have become symbol of Art island of Naoshima. The vellow one is at the edge of a small wharf.
